With these accreditations, High Point and

Weaver reaffirm their rolling commitment to uphold national industry standards as set forth by NIMS, further enabling these Guilford County schools to support the needs of students, their local communities and employers within it, and to the metalworking industry at large.

The accreditation of each of these Guilford County secondary programs focuses on skills from the NIMS Machining Level I National Standard, with an emphasis on manual milling and drill press skills.

Both programs have successfully maintained NIMS accreditation since 2008.
